RE: THE REVIEW OF EXPENSE CLAIMS SUBMITTED BETWEEN

APRIL 1, 2007 AND MARCH 31, 2008, PURSUANT TO THE CABINET

MINISTERS' AND OPPOSITION LEADERS' EXPENSES REVIEW AND

ACCOUNTABILITY ACT, 2002

The Cabinet Ministers' and Opposition Leaders' Expenses Review and Accountability

Act, 2002 (the "Act") requires the Integrity Commissioner to review and approve

expenses claimed by those covered by the Act, direct repayment or recommend other

remedial action. The only expenses covered by the Act are those incurred for travel,

hotels, meals and hospitality.

The Act provides that all expenses incurred by ministers, parliamentary assistants, leaders

of the opposition and their staff must be filed with the Integrity Commissioner by the end

of April in each year and that the Integrity Commissioner is to report annually to the

Speaker of the Legislative Assembly.

A review of all the submitted expense claims for the period April 1, 2007 to March 31,

2008 has been completed, and I am pleased to report that all requests for reimbursements

were complied with and all expense claims reviewed were subsequently approved.

I am grateful for the cooperation of all those who have responded to our requests for

further information about the expense claims.
